



ADMISSIONS INFORMATION for Stover School



FIVE EASY STEPS

ENTRY PROCEDURE

STEP 1 - SCHOOL VISIT

If you are considering joining Stover, the first step is to come and see what makes us special. We will arrange a visit to the School which will include a tour and a meeting with the Headmaster, Mr Notman or Head of Preparatory School, Mr Burt.

STEP 2 - TASTER

Tasters are an opportunity for prospective pupils to experience a day with their peers, to put them at ease and give them a real feel for life at Stover. Taster day assessments are considered alongside your child's current school report before an offer of a place is made. A single day is normally sufficient although tasters of up to a week can be arranged. If you are considering boarding we can also offer a taster sleepover to get a real feel for the family life at Stover.

The aim of the assessment process is to identify potential. Stover School seeks to admit well rounded pupils with a genuine interest in education in the broadest sense of the word, with interests that stretch beyond the confines of the academic curriculum. As well as academic achievement, the school has strong traditions in Music, Drama, Art, Outdoor Pursuits, community activities and Sport. There are many extra-curricular activities, all of which are important in developing a well-balanced, confident individual.

STEP 3 - REGISTRATION

To enter the School we require a completed Registration form, recent school reports, copy of either a birth certificate or passport and a non-refundable Registration Fee of £100. Applications can be received throughout the year.

STEP 4 - OFFER OF A PLACE

Once your application has been approved, we will write to you confirming your child's place and their start date. We request a refundable deposit of £250 (day), £750 (boarder) and that our Acceptance of Parent Contract forms be completed and returned prior to your child starting at Stover. Once your place has been accepted a welcome pack containing more information and various consent forms will be sent out shortly before the start date, required back on/before their first day of school.

STEP 5 - STARTING AT THE SCHOOL

Start dates can be arranged at a time to suit your family although most pupils join us at the beginning of a term. We will be happy to arrange a suitable appointment for you to purchase your uniform from our school shop prior to this date.

STOVER SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

Stover School provides education which nurtures, celebrates, challenges and inspires each pupil. Our holistic approach combines a progressive research based curriculum, with a resilient moral code based on sound family and Christian principles. We prepare confident and independent young people to adapt and succeed in an ever changing world. Stover School does not select children on the basis of academic performance. Instead, our selection process is designed to identify pupils who are able to benefit from our balanced and well-rounded education and who can make a positive contribution towards the life of the school.

INTERNATIONAL ADMISSIONS

If you are unable to visit the school in person, a Skype interview will be arranged with the Head Teacher, Mr Richard Notman. All applicants also sit an English and Mathematics entry paper to ensure that they will benefit from the education at Stover School.

NURSERY

Joining our Nursery is a very simple process. You are welcome to view the Nursery at any time and once registered we will arrange a couple of induction visits to settle your child. All sessions are booked direct with our Nursery Manager, Sharron Hunphries. Our Nursery is extremely popular and usually fully booked over a year in advance, so we would encourage early registration.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are available for Senior School entry and are held in November for Year 12 (Sixth Form) and January for Year 7 (11+, must be under 12 on 1st September) and Year 9 (13+, must be under 14 on 1st September). We offer Academic, Arts (Art, Dance, Drama), Music and Sports Scholarships. The level of Scholarship ranges from 5% to 15%.

BURSARIES

If your child would benefit from an education at Stover but your family is not in a position to cover the full fees then a Bursary can be applied for via Mr Jenkins, the School Bursar. If you have applied for a bursary we would recommend that any place that has been offered is not accepted until the bursary has been confirmed in writing.
