COVID-19 (coronavirus) update 13th March 2020

Following the latest government update, we are continuing to assess the situation with regards to COVID-19.

Please can we remind you of the new advice from Public Health England:

Individuals that have a new cough or a temperature of 37.8c or above are asked to self-isolate at home for a minimum of 7 days. Individuals that have been in contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 are asked to self-isolate at home even if they are symptom free. You should follow the advice sheet

The school has been in contact with Edwin Doran the tour operator for the South Africa trip and Camps International regarding the Uganda trip who will be producing a plan and advice for the school in the near future.

We continue to be in regular contact with Public Health England and the Department for Education Coronavirus Helpline and will reflect any of the medical advice given. Finally, we re-iterate the "Catch It – Kill It – Bin It" campaign and the advice about washing hands thoroughly and frequently
